Why The Primavera Patrons Program?

- Jesus' prayer in John 17:21 was that “They May All Be One”
- Pope John Paul II exhorted Catholics to build a New Springtime –Primavera means Spring
- Pope Francis has said, “Ecumenism isn't Optional”
- In some Catholic diocese over 50% of new marriages are interdenominational
- One study found 2/3 of all marriages between those ages 36-45 were interdenominational
- Nearly 18% of those students attending Catholic Schools are non-Catholic Christians
- Many Catholic families have at least one relative in their family who is a non-Catholic Christian
- There is little ecumenical content like Good News Reports for interdenominational families to enjoy together
- More than half of all Americans say bad news in the media makes them feel stressed, anxious, depressed
- Around 63% of pre-teens and teens 12-18 say negative news makes them feel bad
